

THE AUGUSTINE SCHOLARS

The Augustine Scholars program is designed to provide students who are exceptionally motivated and capable with academic opportunities commensurate with their abilities. In addition to taking a demanding load of honors courses throughout their four years, students will participate in summer enrichment and college preparation opportunities. Students are selected for the Augustine Scholars program when they apply to Carroll in 8th grade, based on an interview, outstanding academic performance, and results of standardized testing. Selected 9th graders may also be issued an invitation to apply at the end of first semester. Students must maintain a high level of academic performance and character to remain Augustine Scholars. Some Augustine Scholars receive academic merit financial aid awards up to 50% of full tuition. Students maintain the privileges of Augustine Scholars all four years of high school by earning a 3.0 cumulative GPA or higher.
